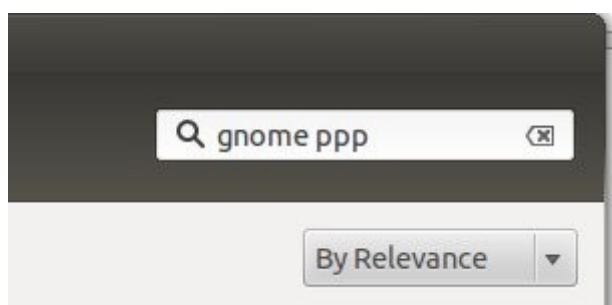


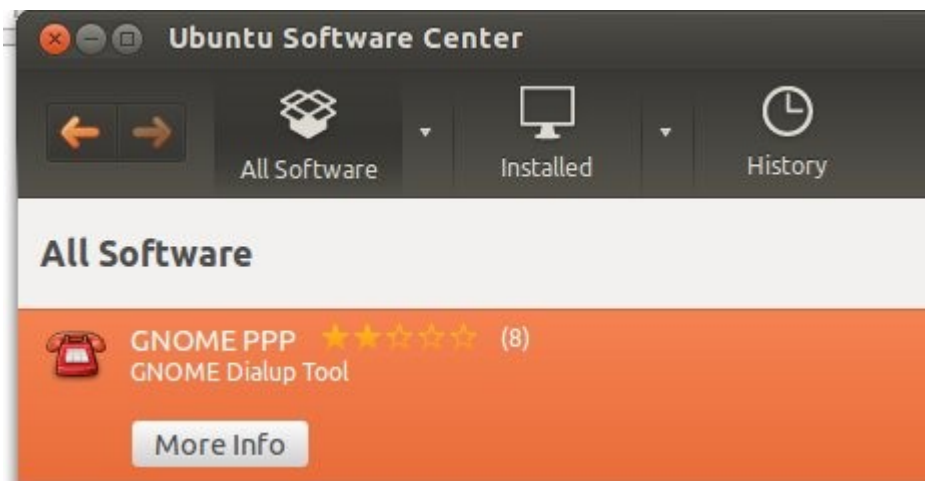
1. Open Ubuntu Software Center



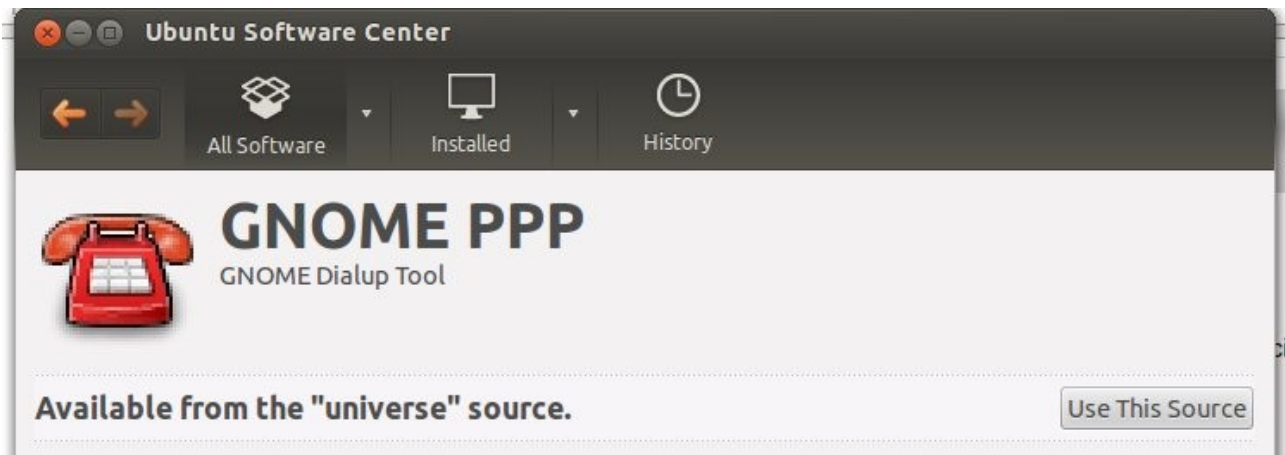
2. Search for gnome ppp dialer



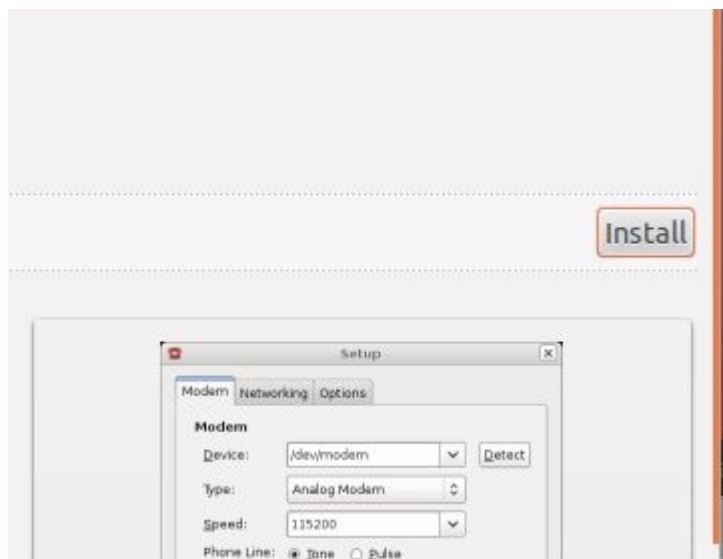
3. Click on More info button once the GNOME PPP dialer tool appears



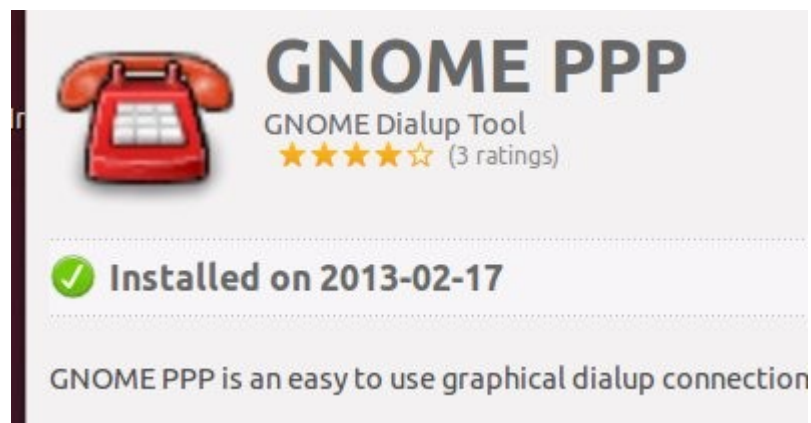
4. Click 'Use This Source'



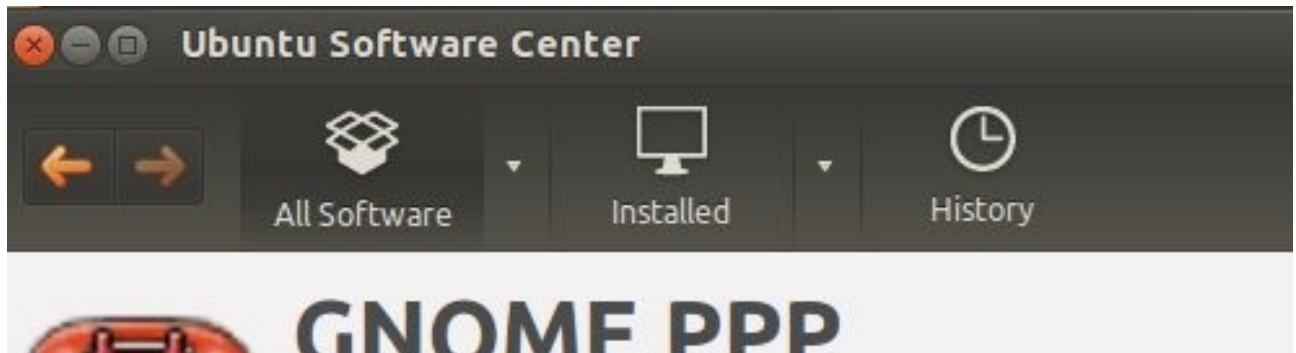
5. Click the Install button on right when it appears



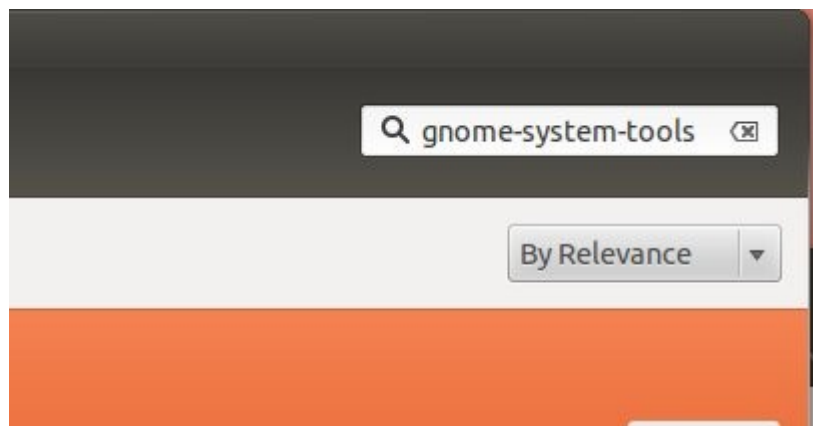
6. When the GNOME dialer tool has finished installing you will see the following:



7. Click All Software button at the top left



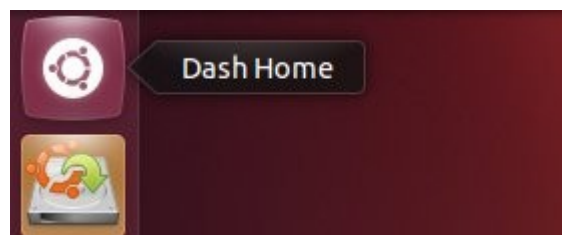
8. At the top right search for gnome-system-tools

10. When done reboot your computer

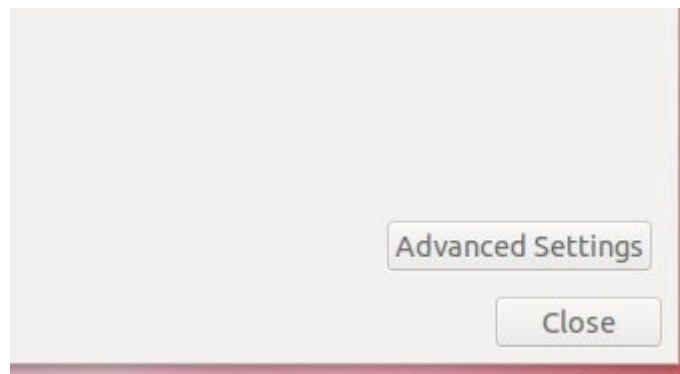
11. Open Dash



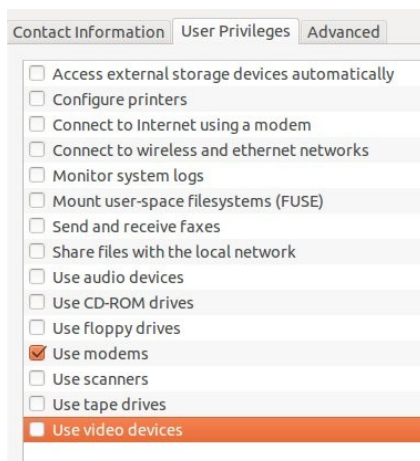
12. Search for user and open Users and Groups

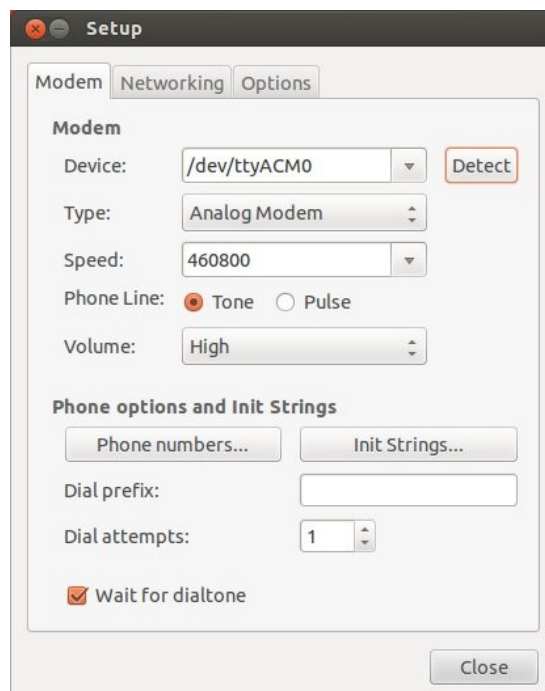
15. Restart the computer
